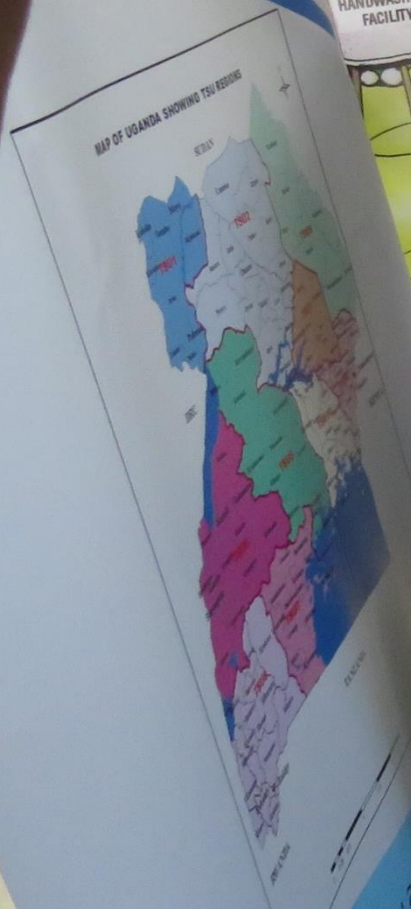

JICA

Japan International Cooperation Agency is the implementing agency for Japan's Official Development Assistance (ODA). JICA provides comprehensive assistance to developing countries, the Uganda through ODA loans, Technical Assistance and Grant Aid then Cooperation through Citizen Participation and Disaster Relief. JICA was restructured in 2008 as an Aid Disbursing Agency (ADA) operating in a more integrated approach. This resulted in improvement of the quality of Japan's ODA operations and implementation of its policy in a more streamlined, effective and efficient manner.

Technical Cooperation

Technical assistance is for human resource development and the formation of administrative systems of developing countries. Technical Cooperation involves the dispatch of experts, the provision of necessary equipment and the training of personnel from developing countries in Japan and other countries. Cooperation plans can be selected at various stages of project. Examples of such projects in Uganda are "The Foundation of Rural Development" (PRAD) project and "Rural Uganda Growth and Livelihood Improvement Project" (RUGLIP), a project with a comprehensive approach focusing on broader sectoral agriculture.

Grant Aid

Grant aid involves provision of funds to developing countries for the execution of projects, without the obligation of repayment. Grant aid can be used for a wide range of activities such as health, water supply facilities and roads, along with health and medical care equipment and other facilities. Examples of such projects in Uganda include the provision of improved water supply to the rural areas of the Northern Uganda and "The Uganda Health Sector Support Project" (USSP), a project with a comprehensive approach focusing on broader sectoral agriculture.

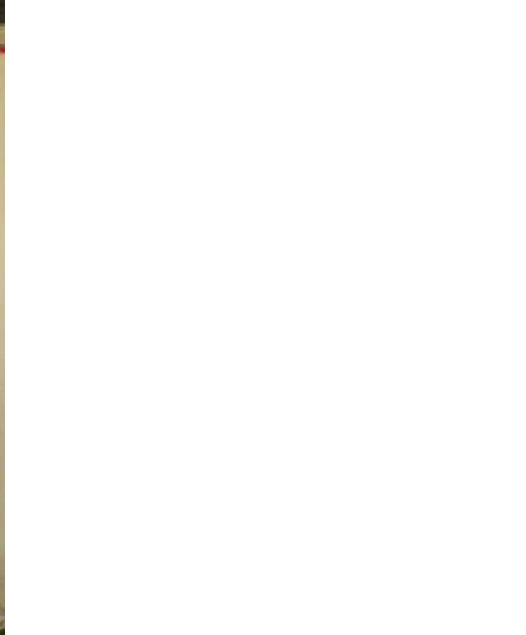
