REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

The main purpose of this consultancy is to develop a robust web-based software which streamlines results based project planning, monitoring and evaluation. A well-functioning M&E system is a critical part of good programme management and accountability. Timely and reliable M&E provides information to: (i) support project implementation with accurate, evidence based reporting and improve project performance, (ii) contribute to organizational learning and knowledge sharing (iii) uphold accountability and compliance as per the requirements, (iv) provide opportunities for stakeholder feedback and up scaling learning. Thus, a M&E system is an important compliance issue for the Water and Environment projects, thereby creating a need for transparent reporting by various development partners using an automated M&E Tool.

The overall objective of this assignment is to develop the Water and Sanitation Subsector Web-Based Monitoring and Evaluation System which will be used during the monitoring, supervision and evaluation of the process and end results of the Water and Environment activities. Specifically, the assignment is intended:

- (i) To develop a Web-Based Monitoring and Evaluation System for the Water and Sanitation Subsector.
- (ii) Refine performance indicators to the results frameworks of the Water and Sanitation Subsector.
- (iii) Develop a data collection tools to be used during the monitoring, mid-tern review and the post evaluation of Ministry's activities.
- (iv) Provide technical services and training to officers in the use of web-based M & E system and database.

The scope of the assignment involves: - Development of an M&E framework, designing a web based M&E system that can run reports, Training officers in the use of the system, review and update the performance indicators and development of appropriate data tools.

The Ministry of Water and Environment now invites eligible Consultancy firms to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested Consultants must provide all necessary legal company documents such as a valid trading licence, certificate of registration and Powers of Attorney.

The short listing criteria will include:

- Eligibility documents
- Prior experience in designing, developing and supporting implementation of a computerized and web-based M&E or MIS system in GoU institutions at a national level
- Relevant qualifications and availability of appropriate skills and personnel for the assignment.
