- Government of Uganda (GoU) has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the Integrated Water Management and Development Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Non-consultancy services for Supporting Communities to Implement Priority Catchment Management Measures in: Lot 1: Lwakhakha Sub Catchment
 - Lot 1. Lwaknakna Sub Catchiner
 - Lot 2: Aswa II Sub Catchment
 - Lot 3: Kochi Sub Catchment
 - Lot 4: Middle/lower Awoja Sub Catchment.
- 2. The Ministry of Water and Environment (MWE) now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for supporting communities in Lwakhakha, Aswa II, Kochi and Middle/lower Awoja sub catchments to; i) restore degraded hotspot wetlands and/or riverbanks, ii) implement soil and water conservation measures on priority hotspots, iii) restore deforested and degraded land through community tree growing on individual farmers land, public land and riverbanks, and iv) establish and promote alternative income generating activities for improved livelihoods.
- 3. The attention of interested consultants is drawn to Section III, paragraphs 3.14, 3.16 and 3.17 of the World Bank's 'Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers' July 2016 revised

November 2018 [Procurement in investment Project Financing; Goods, Works, Non-Consulting and Consulting Services], setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

- 4. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information at the address below and inspect the bidding document during office hours (Monday to Friday, 08:30 17:00 hours, except on public holidays).
- 5. The Bidding Documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders for a non-refundable fee of Uganda Shillings One Hundred Thousand Only (UGX 100,000) prior to submission date. Bids <u>MUST</u> be submitted with evidence of purchase of the bidding documents for Non-consultancy services for Supporting Communities to Implement Priority Catchment Management Measures. Evidence of payment shall first be verified by the responsible officer in Ministry of Water and Environment at time of submission. The method of payment will be by Bank Payment Advice Form obtainable from the Uganda Revenue Authority (URA) website using "Other NTR" as a tax head in the form.
