- 3. Duration of each Assignment: 18 months
- Interested consultants should provide information demonstrating that they are eligible and possess the required qualifications to perform the services supported with relevant documentation.
- The shortlisting criteria will include: Experience in previous contracts of a similar nature; community mobilisation in related

activities and capacity building; Successful bidders should not have conflict of interest in relation to the subject of the procurement, should not be suspended by PPDA, and must demonstrate legal capacity to contract. Bidders should also provide a cover letter, valid trading licence, Certificate of Incorporation, Memorandum and Articles of Association, company profile, Powers of Altorney, evidence of being a local provider. "Local provider" means a provider registered in Uganda whose majority ownership is held by Ugandan citizens. Documents to be submitted in the bid as proof of eligibility to be a local provider include; Return of Allotment of Shares; and copies of the national identity cards or passports of the majority shareholders. Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub consultancy to enhance their qualifications. The form of association, where applicable, should be indicated in the Expression of Interest.

- Preference schemes shall Not apply when evaluating Request for Proposals from the shortlisted consultants.
