# Proposed Undertaking

Develop a water and environment sector comprehensive refugee response framework and implementation roadmap for refugee hosting micro-catchments

#### Short-term Milestone:

Undertake immediate forest and biomass development – "bioenergy plantations" for refugee areas

#### Medium-term Milestone:

- Finalize and roll-out the WASH O&M Framework in refugee and host communities
- ▶ Implement a groundwater monitoring and assessment programme

- Consider refugee neighbouring districts/catchments
- Disaggregate emergency data report in SPR?
